A Personal Note to Board Members, Physicians, Friends:

This week I received 450 capsules for \$150, or 30¢ per capsule, each averaging 244+mg Clotrimazole.

The bottle read:

Vitamin Centre

Clotrimazole 250 mg each capsule contains 250mg of the active ingredient in an insoluble hypoallergenic vehicle, lot 17F, Exp. 6/88. 29.99+ D.F.


From time to time when I cycle through our various antiameobics (except rifampicin and PABA), I find that the presumed amoeba no longer responds. This month was worse than usual, and after some 6 weeks of metronidazole (allopurinol the first week) along with a good grade of Lactibacillus acidophilus (metronidazole requires a good grade of L.a. to metabolize the metronidazole), I knew I was in serious trouble.

I've had Clotrimazole a time or two, and it has always broken the logjam for me.

It has far less toxic side-effects than the other medicines, in my opinion (and for my system); does not have the terrible nausea of metronidazole, nor the metallic taste. It seems to turn on cortisol, inhibit the inflammatory process, kill Candida albicans and, at least in the test tube, various genus of both Acanthamoeba and Naegleria.

Thought you would be interested in this personal experience.
